

Volunteers Wanted!

We are looking for volunteers for The Greatest Ferret Show On Earth! All volunteers will get lanyards this year. The areas we need volunteers for are:

- Friday Set-Up
 - o Who arrive at the show hall the day before and set everything up
- Saturday Take-Down Clean-Up Crew
 - o Who must stay until the very end of the show who take down all chairs, tables, etc. and clean up the show hall when everything is put away
- General Admission
 - o Person who greets the general public and collects admission money, GCFA Members get in free
 - Morning & Afternoon shifts available
- Ferret Registration
 - o First thing in the morning starts at 7am
 - Must arrive at 7am
 - Must collect registration papers, money owed, hand out packets, explain GFSOE bucks, and lanyards to exhibitors and volunteers, registered ferrets only allowed in the show hall
- Raffle Table
 - o Friday Afternoon/Saturday Morning Drop-Off
 - Collect stuff and organize tastefully on the raffle table
 - Make two rounds of raffle stuff
 - o Ticket Sales
 - Roaming and Stationary Positions
 - Must be able to collect money and be trustworthy
- Picture Contest
 - o Must collect pictures, tape them to the board, number them, collect money for entry and for voting
- Announcer
 - o Must be a strong-willed person, have a loud voice to announce what is currently being judged
- Ferret Handler
 - o Person who transports the ferrets in carriers from the announcer stand to the judging area
 - Morning and Afternoon Shifts available
- Show Steward (Score person)
 - o Person who gets all of the score sheets from the Title Judges and enter the scores into the excel form on the computer
 - o Must know Excel

- Steward
 - Person who assists the judge by writing down everything they say, including points and comments
 - Must be able to write legibly and know how to use a calculator to total scores
- GCFA Sales Table
 - Sell stuff for the GCFA
 - Must like people, know how to use a paypal reader
- GCFA Info Table
 - Inform people about the GCFA
 - Collect Donations
 - Must be nice to people
- General Candid Photographer
 - Have a good camera (not a cell phone camera)
 - Know how to take awesome candid photos of people and ferrets
 - Must stay all day
- Winners Photographer
 - Have a good camera (not a cell phone camera)
 - Must stay in the judging area, taking awesome photos of the winners as they are announced
 - Know how to “capture the moment”
- Volunteer Assistant
 - Be the “Go To” person to answer questions incase of questions from Volunteers, incase the Volunteer Coordinator is busy stewarding/showing her ferrets
